*This year we have increased the Book Rental fee ever so slightly. The previous amount had been set for many years. However in the past few years we have increased our spending on new curricular books for the children, particularly in the area of literacy. Since the Covid pandemic we have also increased our spending on equipment for each child in the school and we will continue this next year. Should you have any queries in this regard please do not hesitate to contact us.*

The above payment covers all of the following for the entire school year

- all rental books in all subject areas for all classes
- additional reading materials such as Oxford readers, P.M. readers, Irish books, novels, library books, additional graded reading schemes + Irish book rental.
- all maths equipment
- test booklets
- all copies (regular and hard backed where required) and refill pad for 6<sup>th</sup>.
- plastic book bags
- infant supplies of pencils and crayons
- Posters – maps etc.
- plastic covers for all rental books
- class photocopying for the year (including paper)
- all art + craft supplies (paper, paint, clay etc)
- reports/envelopes + postage
